

Monroe County Jail Application/ Process Hacks



How do I apply to get cleared?

You must fill out the application and include a picture of your photo ID. The application can be found on the AA website (www.rochester-ny-aa.org) or at Central Office.

You must attend the Facility Orientation. The Orientation schedule can be found on the AA website (www.rochester-ny-aa.org) or at Central Office.

How do I fill out the application?

- Organization: *Alcoholics Anonymous*
- Phone number: *585-232-6720*
- Supervisor's name and Supervisor's phone: *n/a*
- Clearance Type you are requesting? *AA*
- Do you have a Criminal Record? Are you on Probation or Parole?

Have you ever been arrested? *If "yes", list any charges under "please explain". If you are unclear on your criminal history, you may obtain a copy of your criminal history at the Records office at the Hall of Justice.*

- Sponsor's signature: *Leave blank*
- Applicant's signature: *Application must signed and dated.*

What do I do next?

- First, submit your application to Central Office. You will need to include a Copy of Driver's License or Photo ID w/ DOB
- Second, when you submit your application, you will need to know when you are going to attend Volunteer Orientation which the date should be at least 7 days from when you submit your application. **Then wait to you hear from the Corrections Committee if you have been cleared to attend the Volunteer Orientation.**

- **You may mail your application or physically drop off to Mary at: AA Central Office, 1000 Elmwood Avenue, Greenhouse Rochester, New York 14620**
